Technical Coordinator (Special Project)

Responsibilities:

1. Handle assigned programmes' technical coordination in coordination and negotiation with performing companies/artists, including supervising all relevant technical and production preparation and being onsite for load-in, set-up, rehearsals, performances and strike-out;
2. Prepare and attend artist rehearsals locally in Hong Kong;
3. Liaise with venues, licensing authorities, contractors and service providers for smooth load-in and load-out and efficient set-up and presentation of performances in accordance with regulations and ordinances laid out by venue management;
4. Supervise local contractors and freelance technicians/workers onsite, ensuring their efficiency and safety at all working levels;
5. Communicate with partners such as the disability support organisations as well as HKAF's internal teams to ensure the smooth delivery of the special project;
6. Prepare, administer and account for all technical expenditures for assigned programmes and ensure that proper procurement procedures are followed.

Requirements:

1. A recognized university/academic degree in technical/stage management, lighting, sound engineering or an equivalent;
2. At least 6 years of relevant experience, of which at least 3 were in a supervisory position;
3. Proficient in Microsoft Office and AutoCAD;
4. Extensive technical experience in various stage productions, including technical operations and management;



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5. Have good communication skills, fluency in both spoken and written English and Chinese;
6. Knowledge of the NGO sector/social service in Hong Kong;
7. First aid certificate valid until 30 March 2026 will be an advantage.
