- Translating editorial materials (Chinese and English) for our festival magazine, house programmes and surtitles
- Copyediting, formatting and proofreading of various bilingual publications
- Completing writing assignments independently
- Conducting programme-related research
- Record-keeping and administrative tasks as assigned

Requirements:

- Full-time university student in a relevant discipline (preferably in arts, literature, translation, music or archival studies)
- Eligible work experience student or student intern under the Minimum Wage Ordinance (Cap. 608)
- Able to work at least two full days in office per week within a 59-calendar day period
- Good command of written English and Chinese
- Proactive, organised and detail-oriented with a willing-to-learn attitude
- Organised, self-motivated and able to handle multiple tasks
- A knowledge of and passion for the performing arts/Classical music are a plus

Outcome

- Interns will gain practical experience in researching and documenting the performing arts, as well as valuable training in writing, translation, editing and arts administration
- The internship may be extended after the initial three-month period depending upon performance

This internship is exempted from the Statutory Minimum Wage under the Minimum Wage Ordinance (Cap. 608)

Work experience students will be required to sign and submit the statutory declaration made by a work experience student for a period of exempt student employment and a confirmation of student status for “work experience student”.

Allowance: \$100 meal and transportation allowance will be provided per working day (eight hours) for work experience students during the period of exemption from the Statutory Minimum Wage.

Students may also apply for credit-bearing internships as **student interns** to fulfil the compulsory or elective components of their course. They will be required to sign and submit the confirmation of student status for “student intern” and arrange necessary documents with their education institutions providing the programmes.
