- Set an annual target plan, liaise closely with the Education Bureau, school principals,
 teachers-in-charge, universities, tertiary and partnering institutions about the outreach programmes;
- Design an annual recruitment campaign to secondary schools and tertiary institutions, introducing the Festival and its programmes;
- Recruit and supervise staff for special projects such as special students matinees, artists-in-residence projects and community projects;
- Promote and publicize the outreach programmes and supervise the production quality of the website,
 digital and printed materials;
- Prepare the annual budget and year-end report;
- Assist the Programme Director in overseeing the music programmes of the Festival;
- Source and schedule programmes;
- Monitor programme progress and participate in the development, implementation and review of programme planning and strategy.

- Well versed in the performing arts;
- Good knowledge of classical and other types of music;
- Dedicated, self-motivated and well-organized;
- Strong project management, analytical, problem-solving and communication skills;
