

Resident Artist (Intern) (12 months)

Unlock Dancing Plaza is offering a 12-month full-time Resident Artist Internship in support of Hong Kong Arts Development Council.

Unlock Dancing Plaza (UDP) is a HK based contemporary dance company and the grantee of "three-years-grant of the Hong Kong Arts Development Council. The Artistic Direction focuses on the exploration of body and develops programmes for theatre performance, community workshops for kids, elderly and more.

The Resident Artist Intern is expected to have adequate skills and great interest in dance and movement for performing and teaching. Auditions are scheduled at 5 - 10pm of the 19th of Aug & 4 - 9pm of the 20th of Aug.

Duties of Resident Artist Internship:

- Perform in the Company's productions and demonstrate a good level of artistry and techniques.
- Teach in the Company's education and outreach programmes and demonstrate a good communication skill to the participants, including elderlies, children and the general public.
- Assist the Artistic Director and Creative Director (Public Participation) in the creative process.
- Research on teaching materials and lesson plan for education & outreach programmes

The candidate should satisfy the following requirements:

- A resident of Hong Kong.
- A recent performing arts or related degree/curriculum (e.g. dance, physical movement, theatre or other training in related discipline) graduate who has completed his/her studies in Hong Kong or abroad within the past three years; a final-year student in the aforementioned disciplines can also be considered.
- Pursue dance at a professional performance level.
