The ideal candidate possesses a curatorial background, exceptional interpersonal skills, and a strong passion and pride for Chinese culture, resonating with the mission of Sun Museum. We are seeking a team-oriented individual who will drive our exhibitions and enrich our organizational culture through shared values and commitment to collective success.

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Develop and oversee the museum's exhibition program, including conceptualizing, planning, and executing exhibitions
- Support the museum director in leading the curatorial team to deliver high-quality, engaging, and impactful exhibitions and programs
- Compile and publish comprehensive exhibition catalogs that showcase the featured artworks, provide in-depth analysis, and serve as lasting educational resources
- Develop educational programs, workshops, or public programs that complement the exhibitions to promote Chinese art and culture
- Engage with the local community, develop relationships and collaborate with artists, collectors, cultural organizations to enrich our reach, exhibition, and program offerings

- Conduct research on the museum's art collections and Chinese art history to enhance the quality and depth of exhibitions and catalogs
- Manage the museum's collections of art and books, including acquisition, cataloging, and preservation

- Master's degree in art history, Chinese studies, museum studies, or a related field
- Minimum 8 years of curatorial experience in a museum or art gallery setting
- Extensive knowledge of Chinese art history, culture, and contemporary art practices in Hong Kong
- Strong research, writing, and public speaking skills in both Chinese and English
- Excellent project management and team leadership skills
- Fluency in Chinese (Cantonese and Mandarin) and English
- 5-day work week between Tuesday to Sunday
