



### **Resident Répétiteur (18-month Contract)**

Musica Viva is a not-for-profit charitable organisation founded in October 2008. Musica Viva's vision is to promote performing arts of creative originality in their various forms and genres, in particular the appreciation, study, education and performance of music, opera and vocal art, as well as to create opportunities for creative and professional career development for budding artists.

This position is financially supported by HKADC's "Arts Talents Internship Matching Programme" (ATIM), aiming to provide local emerging musicians with opportunities for apprentice and honing their musical talents. Through their internships, musician interns will acquire and accumulate formal stage experience towards developing musical proficiency, reaching professional maturity, and ultimately enhancing their long-term professional development in music.

#### **Responsibilities**

- Researching into historical repertoire, both in operas and in classical music. General knowledge of repertoire is crucial to the position of répétiteur, and will only serve to make better, more well-rounded musicians.
- Gaining experience with foreign languages including French, German, Italian, and Spanish. General knowledge of such languages is vital to a répétiteur, which enables them to be a better accompanist, and to offer effective coaching to singers.
- Collaborating with artists, particularly through accompanying singers of an international standard.
- Pursuing technical expertise with the piano in both rehearsal and performance settings.
- Learning how to deal with various copyright issues.
- Working with the Librarian to enhance their understanding of scores and learn effective research procedures.
- Assisting the conductor with their associated tasks.
- Practically applying their skills and creativity in interpreting music.
- Job duties will be adjusted throughout the contract period based on the candidate's abilities.

#### **Requirement**

- Candidates must be permanent residents of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region aged 18 or above.
- Associate Degree Graduates or Higher Diploma Holders of local or overseas tertiary institutes or above, obtained within the last 3 school years at the time of application.

- Aspires to pursue music at a professional performance level.
